



Homeowner Electrical Maintenance Checklist

Use this checklist to help keep your home's electrical system safe, efficient, and up to code.

- Know the location of your electrical panel and label all breakers clearly.
- Test all GFCI outlets monthly using the 'Test' and 'Reset' buttons.
- Investigate flickering or dimming lights promptly to avoid larger issues.
- Avoid overloading circuits with too many devices or power strips.
- Check for warm or discolored outlets and switches—these may signal a wiring issue.
- Always use the correct wattage bulbs in fixtures to prevent overheating.
- Inspect extension cords regularly and avoid using them as permanent wiring.
- Install or maintain a whole-home surge protector for added safety.
- Schedule a professional electrical inspection every 3–5 years.
- Call a licensed electrician for any burning smells, buzzing sounds, or frequent breaker trips.
